that power be- I longs to God.


<sup>12</sup>Steadfast love belongs to <sup>|</sup> you, O Lord,


# **OFFERING PRAYER -** All speak the prayer together.

# LORD'S PRAYER


Our Father, who art in heaven hallowed be thy name,
